LIFT Link is an online collaboration platform that fosters interaction among utilities, academics, consultants, investors, and technology providers. Here, Affiliates can discover the latest technologies, connect with others who have similar interests, and collaborate on projects and demonstrations. Affiliates can also learn about high-priority research and technology needs, find experts to help meet these needs, and more.



## IDENTIFY NEW TECHNOLOGIES

LIFT Technology Scans offer technology providers a platform to introduce new technologies to facility owners, consultants, venture capitalists, regulators, and others to accelerate advancement and early adoption. Affiliates can help identify promising technologies from their own networks to participate in the LIFT Technology Scan process.



### FIND OR BECOME A TEST FACILITY

Affiliates can work with local utilities and universities to integrate facilities from their region into an international test bed network, FAST (Facilities Accelerating Science and Technology) Water Network. It connects innovators in the water industry with appropriate test facilities.


The University-Utility Partnership program allows Affiliates to leverage LIFT's network and ongoing activities to strengthen academic and utility connections. This provides greater opportunities for educational outreach and utility-relevant research.



The Scholarship Exchange Experience for Innovation & Technology (SEE IT) awards \$30K annually in scholarships for utility personnel to see innovative technologies in use. SEE IT is sponsored by WRF, WEF, and the National Association of Clean Water Agencies.



LIFT Challenges give students, professionals, and technology aficionados the opportunity to showcase their talents and awards their efforts with cash prizes. The first challenge was launched in 2018 and tasked entrants to tackle utility problems using intelligent water systems.
